GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION.

Government is pleased to direct that the following terms and conditions shall apply in respect of foreign service of all Revenue Officers deputed to Municipalities for revising assessment lists or hearing appeals against the assessments.

(i) That the deputed officer shall get his grade pay and dearness allowance, compensatory and House Rent Allowance admissible under rules.

(ii) Besides the above mentioned pay and allowance he shall also be paid a deputation allowance at 20 per cent of his grade pay and such conveyance allowance as may be considered necessary by the Director of Local Authorities subject to a maximum of Rs. 60 per mensem.

(iii) That the Travelling Allowance and Joining Time pay both on transfer to the Municipality and on reversion therefrom shall be paid by the Municipalities concerned in accordance with the Bombay Civil Services Rules.

paid by the Municipality or Municipalities concerned in accordance with the rates prescribed by the Government of Bombay from time to time;

(v) That the whole expenditure in respect of any compensatory allowance for periods of leave taken by the deputed officer while in or at the end of foreign service shall be borne by the Municipalities concerned.

(vi) That the Municipalities concerned shall be liable to pay leave salary in respect of any disability incurred in and through such foreign service, even though

such disability manifests itself after the examination of foreign service;

(vi) That while serving under the Municipality the deputed officer shall be subject to the provision in Government Resolution, Finance Department, No.7840/33, dated 30th November 1949.

2. These orders will apply to all revenue officers who have already been deputed to various Municipalities and in whose cases individual orders have not been issued and also to those who will be deputed after the issue of these orders.
