Resolution:-When land is acquired and its possession taken  
over by the acquiring body or department, be it under any Act,  
it is not justifiable to continue to recover land revenue from  
the previous owners merely on the technical grounds of the non-  
declaration of the final award, the non-approval of valuation  
etc. Government is, therefore, pleased to direct that the orders  
issued in Government Resolution, No.4802/45, dated 2nd March 1948,  
should apply as well to land which is acquired under the  
Requisitioned Land(Continuance of Powers) Act, 1947, and whose  
possession is handed over to the acquiring body or department.
