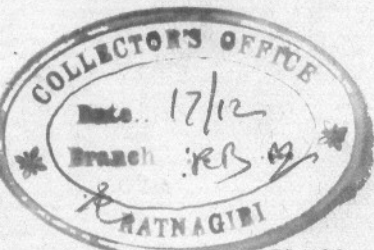
Read Government Resolution, No. BND. 1354, dated the 23rd May 1955.

RESOLUTION.—In modification of the orders contained in Government Resolution, No. BND. 1354, dated 23rd May 1955, Government is pleased to direct that,

(a) in selecting the villages for the decennial programme for the repairs of boundary marks, the villages in charge of each Circle Inspector should be so distributed over 10 year period that he would have to attend to equal number of survey numbers (as nearly as practicable) every year ; and

(b) the Mamlatdars (including the Mamlatdars in Konkan tract) should inspect all boundary marks of at least 20 survey numbers in each village under the boundary marks programme.
