RESOLUTION:- Consequent upon the appointment of the Divisional Officers and the delegation of the powers to them to transfer Mamlatdars and Mahalkaris from a taluka or a part of taluka in the Division to another, Government is pleased to authorise the Divisional Officers :-

i) to grant leave for a period upto 4 months to officers in Mamlatdar's grade under them;

ii) to make necessary arrangements in consequence of such grant of leave as well as other types of local arrangements such as arising out of death, accident, training etc.

iii) to give on loan officers in Mamlatdar's grade to other Departments such as Municipalities, etc., in their respective Divisions for short duration, not exceeding six months and to make appointments in vacancies so caused;

iv) to order postings of officers in Mamlatdar's grade returning from leave, deputation, etc. if necessary, by reverting junior-most officers in the Division;

v) to maintain and review annually the confidential reports of officers in Mamlatdar's grade under them.

2. Government is also pleased to authorise the Divisional Officers to grant leave for a period upto 30 days to Deputy Collectors and other Revenue Officers in that grade in their respective Division. The power to grant leave to Deputy

Collectors delegated to the Collectors under Government Circular, No.378/49, dated 11th September 1950 should be treated as cancelled.

3. The Divisional Officers should further be authorised to notify under their signature in the Bombay Government Gazette the nature of leave granted by him after duly ascertaining the same from the Accountant General or the Additional Accountant General or the Deputy Accountant General, as the case may be, holding of additional charge, appointments of acting incumbents and postings of officers returning from leave or deputation sanctioned by them under the powers delegated to them under the Resolution.

4. The powers now exercised by Collectors in respect of grant of leave to officers in Mamlatdar's cadre would continue to vest in them.

5. The Divisional Officers should be asked to endorse copies to Government for its information of the orders issued by them under the powers now delegated to them.
