Grant-in-aid to the District

Resolution No. QRY.1057/64341-A.

Sachivalaya, Bombay, 11th April 1957.

RESOLUTION: According to the procedure laid down in Government Resolution, Revenue Department, No.215/39, dated 20th June 1939, all quarry fees are being credited to head "VII-Land Revenue" and equivalent amounts debitable to the head "57-Miscellaneous Contributions" are paid to the District Local Boards concerned and necessary provision is being made in the budget estimates every year for that purpose. Consequent upon the introduction of the Bombay Minor Minerals Extractions Rules, 1955, Government has, in Government Resolution, Development Department, No. MNL-1754/59109-M, dated 26th April 1955, directed that the receipts on account of fees, rents and royalties realised under the provisions of those rules should be credited to the new budget head "XXXII-Industries" which is being controlled by the Industries and Co-operation Department. It has now been decided that the work of distribution of grants to the District Local Boards and Village Panchayats on account of such fees and also of making necessary provision for that purpose in the annual budget estimates should be done by the Industries and Co-operation Department with effect from the year 1957-58. The Collectors are accordingly requested to submit the necessary budget estimates and monthly statements to the Industries and Co-operation Department in future.

B | 2. In Government Resolution, Local Self Government and Public Health Department, No.VPA.1253, dated 25th April 1955, Government has decided that the Village Panchayats should be paid the amount of quarry fees realised in their respective areas and District Local Boards should be paid the amount realised in their respective areas, excluding the areas under the jurisdiction of the Village Panchayats. In pursuance of this decision Government is pleased to direct that the Collectors should take steps to distribute the grants on account of quarry fees among the District Local Boards and Village Panchayats concerned and that the grants payable to the Village Panchayats should be paid to the Village Panchayats directly.
