RESOLUTION:- Under the Maharashtra Agricultural Lands (Ceiling on Holdings) Act, 1961 a ceiling or upper limit has been imposed on all agricultural holdings. For deciding the extent of surplus land in each holding the Collector (or Deputy Collector) has to conduct necessary inquiry under section 17 and 18 and to make declaration under section 21, giving inter-alia, the particulars of lands so declared surplus. It is only after such a declaration is made and a notification giving particulars of surplus land is published in the Gazette that the possession of such land can be taken and their disposal made in accordance with the provisions of section 27 of the Act. In order to ensure that such surplus land becomes available for disposal well before the cultivation season of 1965-66 begins, it was necessary to see that the declaration of surplus lands under section 21 were made as quickly as possible. For this purpose it was necessary to augment the revenue staff in those Districts where the work was particularly heavy. Proposals for additional staff were, therefore, called for from the Commissioners. After carefully considering the proposals submitted by them, Government is pleased to sanction with effect from the date(s) of appointment, the staff as mentioned in the appended statement for the period ending 28th February 1965 in the first instance.

2. The Deputy Collectors, Aval Karkuns, Clerk-cum-typists and peons should be allowed to draw dearness allowance and other allowances as admissible under the rules in force.
3. The posts of Deputy Collectors should be treated as temporary addition to the permanent cadre of Deputy Collectors and the posts of Aval Karkuns, clerk-cum-typists, peons and attendants should be treated as temporary addition to the respective permanent cadres in the district concerned.
4. The expenditure should be debited to the budget head "19-General Administration-E-District Administration-Q-General Establishment-Q-I-General Establishment" and should be met from the grants sanctioned thereunder during the year 1964-65.
5. Government is also pleased to direct that -
  - i) The Special Deputy Collector(Land Ceilings), Ravalgaon Sugar Farm Limited should be entrusted with the work of disposing

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
of other cases under the Ceiling Act, in Malegaon and Niphad sub-divisions. Requisite notification giving jurisdiction to the Special Deputy Collector in these two- sub-divisions under the Ceiling Act has been published in the Maharashtra Government Gazette, Part IV-B, Extraordinary dated 4th December 1964.

ii) The Special Deputy Collector (Land Ceilings), Chitale Agricultural Products Limited and Saswad Mali Sugar Factory should also be entrusted with the work of disposing of inquiries under the Ceiling Act, in the Karmala; Madha, Mohal, Pandharpur, Mangalvedha and Songala talukas in Sholapur District. Requisite notification giving necessary jurisdiction to the Special Deputy Collector in these talukas has already been published in the Maharashtra Government Gazette Extraordinary Part IV-B, dated the 4th December 1964.

iii) Posts of the Special Deputy Collector (Land Reforms) have been provisionally sanctioned for each of the eight districts of Vidarbha Region for the work relating to the implementation of Tenancy Act. These Special Deputy Collectors (Land Reforms) should also be given work pertaining to the Land Ceiling Act in their respective districts. Requisite Notification empowering them to exercise the powers and perform the duties of Collector under the Ceiling Act and giving necessary jurisdiction to them, is being issued separately.

6. This Government Resolution issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, vide its un-official reference No.19626/D-2026/III, dated the 2nd January 1965.
